Information Pack/FAQ's

When is the Snowdon challenge taking place?

The Snowdon Challenge will take place on Saturday 8th July 2017 from 7am-10pm.

How do I register?

You will need to register in advance to take part in the Snowdon Challenge and pay a non-refundable registration fee of £30 to cover administration and the costs of staging this charity challenge event.

There are 3 ways you can register for the Snowdon Challenge:

1. You can register on-line and securely pay your registration fee by debit or credit card via eventbrite. Visit www.afsnowdonchallenge2017.eventbrite.co.uk
2. Obtain a registration form (and information pack) through the post by sending an email to: info@abrahamicfoundation.org.uk
3. By phoning the office on 0121 448 9800

Is there a limit to the number of people able to take part?

For logistical and environmental reasons the maximum number of people taking part in the Snowdon Challenge will be limited to 50 in total. To ensure that you are one of them it is advisable to register for the event as soon as you can. The web site will say if / when the maximum number has been reached.

How much money will I have to raise?

Obviously as much as you can but while we're asking all participants to aim to raise £200 or more for adults and £100 for children under the age of 8, we recognise that for some that might be difficult. So for those unable to raise £200 we simply ask you to do your best and raise as much as you can.

How much of the sponsorship funds raised will go directly to the Abrahamic foundation?

Your £30 registration fee will help cover the administration and other costs of staging the Snowdon Challenge. Our aim is therefore that 100% of all sponsorship funds raised will go directly to The Abrahamic foundation and its projects.

How should the funds I raise be paid to The Abrahamic Foundation?

There are few ways to do this:

1. Create and set up your own page on the MyDonate web site. Your sponsors will then be able to pay on line and the funds will go directly to The Abrahamic Foundation. 2. Send a cheque made payable to The Abrahamic Foundation for the amount you have raised together with your completed sponsorship. They can be given to Brother Kamran alternatively you can post to our office 215 High Street, Smethwick B66 3AH

How long will it take?

If you are an experienced walker with good fitness levels the walk should take you about five hours. Less experienced walkers can expect to take a little longer to complete the ascent and descent. Remember the Snowdon Challenge is not a race but a personal or team challenge to raise vital funds for The Abrahamic Foundation.

Will there be anyone to help me on route?

Local safety marshals with considerable experience of Snowdon will be deployed along the route up and down to help keep you safe and to make sure that you do not accidentally stray from the designated routes.

What sort of level of physical fitness will I need?

Climbing Mt Snowdon is easily achievable by anyone in reasonable health and of average fitness. The age of participants who have taken part in previous Snowdon Challenges ranges from 7 up to 80.

What if I have medical problems?

If you have any medical problems (epilepsy, diabetes, high blood pressure, and allergies for example) you should seek medical advice before registering for this event. The registration form for Snowdon asks you let us know about any medical problems you may have so that we are aware and in case we need to organise assistance on the day.

What do I need to bring with me on the day?
